What are your first thoughts when you tell someone you share God's word at work? What comes to mind? Do you ask if they go to church, or maybe where they go? At New Day Center, we share the gospel in several different ways as we conduct our education programs. In some cases, we have parents who are eager to do Bible studies with our Educator. Or it could be as simple as a prayer to start or close an education session.

Rachel, the Director of Bridge Ministries for Christian Life Resources, our parent organization, visited New Day Center earlier this year. One of the main focuses of her visit was to show us simple ways to share God's Word with our clients. One of her ideas, she purchased a jar from the thrift store (the New Day Thrift Store, of course!) and filled it with Bible passages.

This may seem like a small or trivial idea, but it is very rewarding not only for the clients, but for staff as well. As clients come in to pick up diapers or at the end of an in-person session, they choose a verse from the jar and read it. We take the opportunity to ask how this verse affects them in the moment or with whatever life issue they are dealing with. As you know, with God there are no "accidents" and there have been many times when the client says, "Wow, this is what I needed today!"

This has encouraged us to share God's Word on other simple items, such as bookmarks, key chains and bracelets. A table with these items sits in the New Day reception area, and clients are always encouraged to take one.

Clients and staff alike go about their daily lives, whether it be at work, running errands or to family gatherings, displaying one of these everyday items with a Bible verse on it. What a simple way to open the door to conversations about Jesus! None of what we do at New Day Center is done for our attention or recognition, but instead to show how wonderful our God is and how, through our words and actions, HE is praised.



So then, how can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one about whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without a preacher? And how can they preach unless they are sent? And just as it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news of peace, who preach the gospel of good things!"
